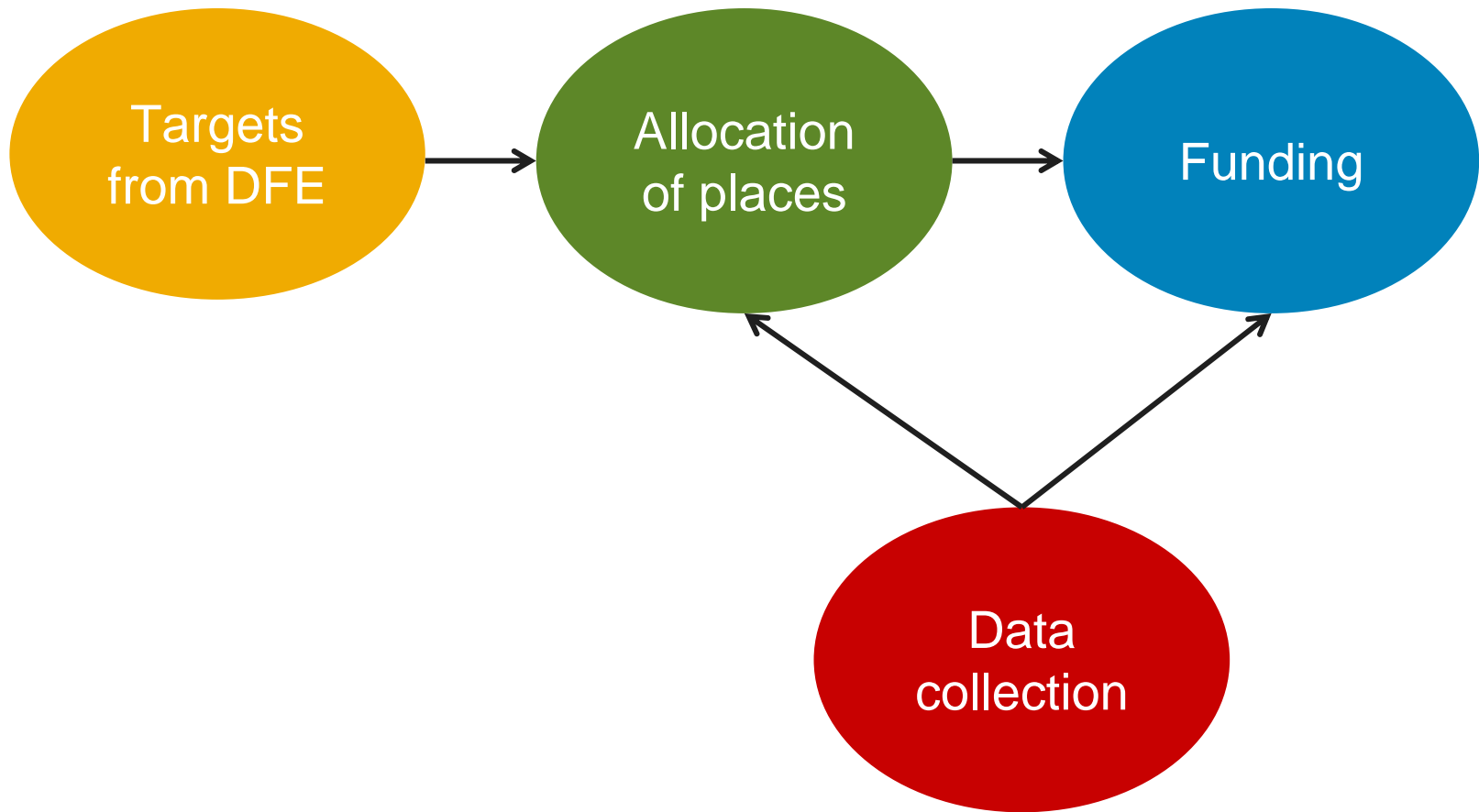

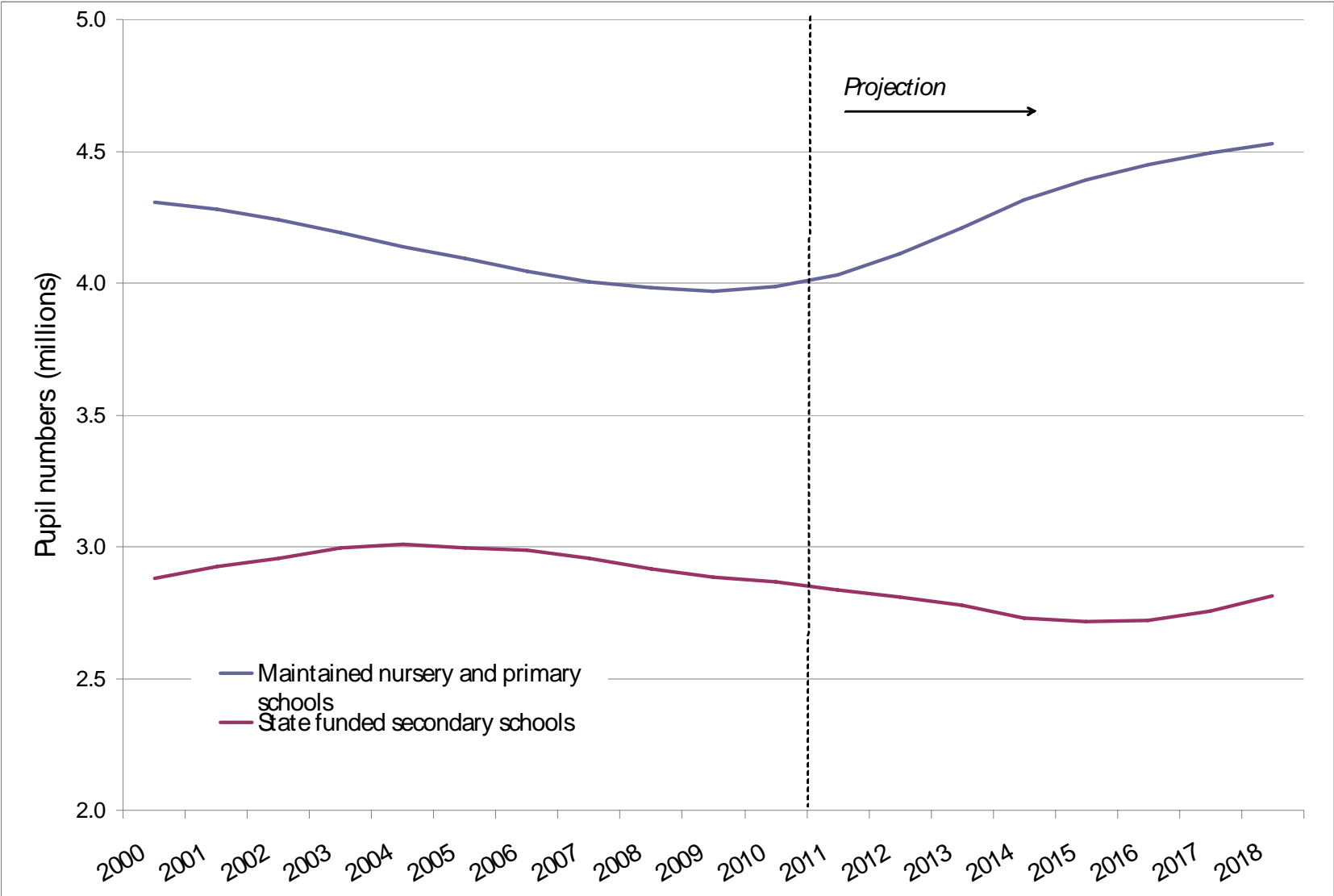

- Quality of provision as measured by Ofsted
- Historical performance

Routes

- Mainstream
 - traditional Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE)
 - Undergraduate Degree (BEd)
 - PGCE at a School Centred Initial Teacher Training provider (SCITT)
 - Employment Based Routes – such as the Graduate Teacher Programme or Teach First

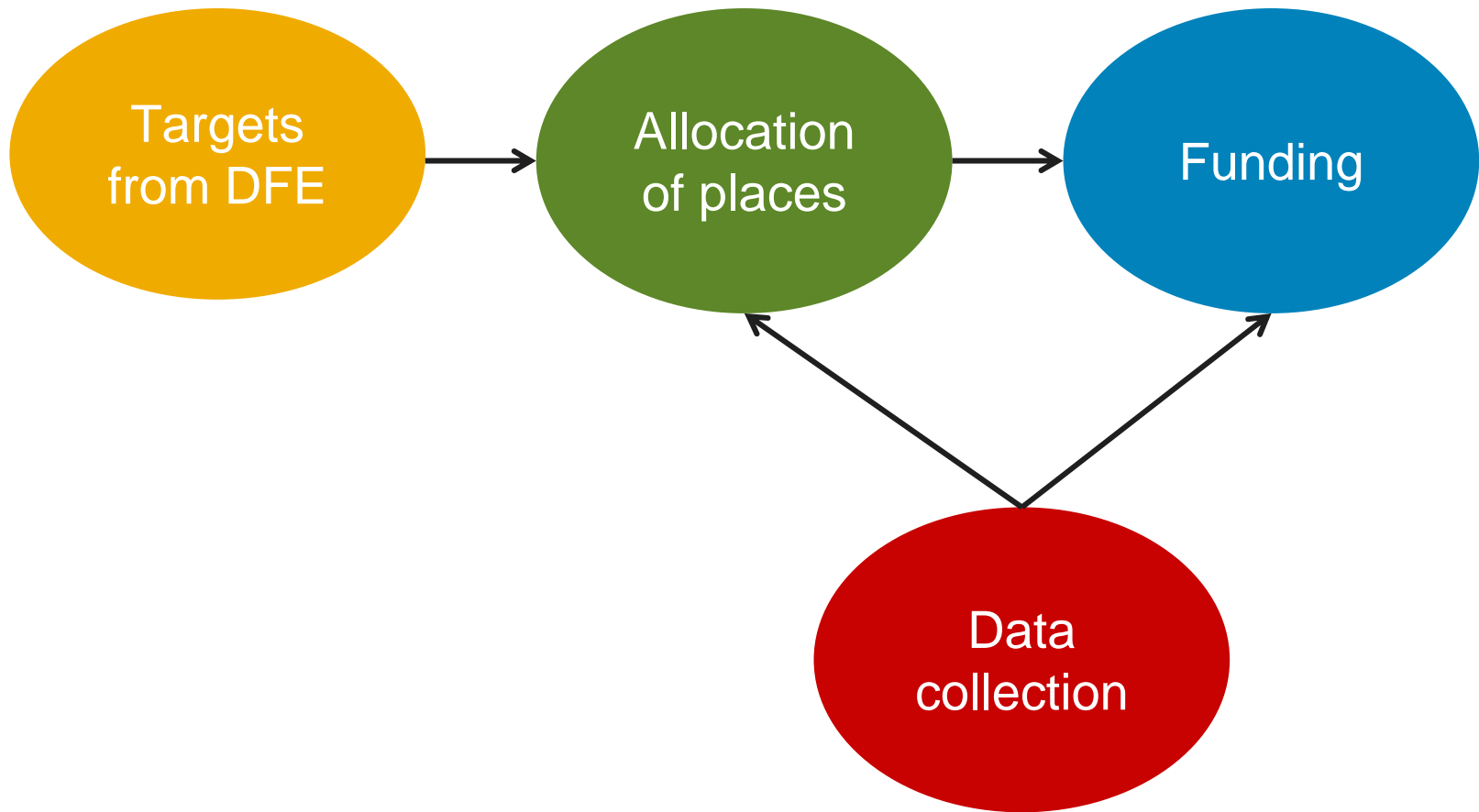
Funding

- Funding is paid per trainee registered (c. £5,000 to £7,000)
- Additional funding is available for trainees in the form of bursaries for:
 - £9,000
 - Physics
 - Chemistry
 - Mathematics
 - £6,000
 - Biology and general science
 - Modern foreign languages

Reporting and data processes

- We collect data through:
 - HESA (Higher Education Statistics Agency)
 - EBITT Data Management System
 - SCITT Data Management System
 - Audited accounts
